### Summary

The Props Apprentice helps facilitate a positive and enjoyable Props Shop environment. The Props Department is responsible for completing projects having to do with the construction, restoration, or modification of furniture, set dressing, and hand props using a variety of materials and methods. Holistic effective communication and dissemination of information is essential to the successful execution of this position.

### Duties and Responsibilities

- Help maintain a safe, educational, and productive prop shop.
- Ensure excellence and quality of work.
- Build necessary furniture/set dressing/hand prop pieces needed for a production.
- Repair and/or modify stock items needed for a production.
- Stewardship of tools and supplies in your work area.
- Assigned organization and improvement of stock.
- Regular communication with Props Master to accurately realize the creative vision of the design.
- Create and update props lists.
- Be prepared to assist other crews/departments at the end of season strike until dismissed by Production Management.
- Update and maintain props inventory.
- Attend all load- ins and outs.
- Run shows as required.
- Attend regular production meetings.

- Other duties as assigned by supervisor.
- Supervised by the Props Master and Director of Production.

### **Qualifications**

- Strong communication skills.
- Highly motivated.
- Good attitude and work ethic.
- Willingness to take ownership of your position and not blame other staff members or outside circumstances for your degree of success on individual tasks and on your position as a whole.
- Able to take instruction and feedback from supervisors and use it to improve your job performance.

### **Requirements and Compensation**

- Complete satisfactory background check
- Must have valid state driver's license and possess a clean driving record
- The Props Apprentice includes a season stipend of \$1000 paid bi-weekly, full board, and on-campus housing
