## Announcing Brevard Music Center's 2023/24 Parker Concert Hall Series

World-Class Lineup Opens With Renowned Cellist Johannes Moser and Celebrated Pianist Marc-André Hamelin on October 3

Aug 25, 2023 - Brevard Music Center announces the 2023/24 season of performances at Parker Concert Hall on its Brevard, NC campus. The state-of-the-art venue overlooking scenic Lake Milner will play host to a twelve-concert series beginning October 3 with celebrated artists Johannes Moser and Marc-André Hamelin in a cello/piano duo recital. Other highlights include the award-winning Eroica Trio, a Valentine concert with jazz vocalist Halie Loren, St. Patrick's Day with the Derina Harvey Band, and a rare recital appearance by world renowned pianist Olga Kern.

The multi-genre series opens on October 3 with cellist Johannes Moser and pianist Marc-André Hamelin. The award-winning Eroica Trio makes their Brevard debut on October 26 in an eclectic and innovative program. The amazing pipa virtuoso Min Xiao-Fen is joined by percussionist River Guerguerian in a special showing of classic Chinese cinema with live instrumental accompaniment on November 9. The next generation of superstars from the famed Curtis Institute of Music join their legendary mentors Osmo Vänskä and Erin Keefe on November 28 in Curtis on Tour. Mike Guggino and Barrett Smith from the GRAMMY-winning Steep Canyon Rangers host their annual audience-favorite Italian Night on December 11, and the international sensation Chrsitmas with the Celts on December 14 is sure to put everyone in the holiday spirit.

After the new year, the series continues on **February 14** with jazz vocalist **Halie Loren** in a special Valentine's Day celebration of love and romance. The **Israeli Chamber Project** performs an engaging program of classical favorites and lesser-known gems on **February 29**. Celebrate St. Patrick's Day and all things Irish with **The Derina Harvey Band** on **March 12**. With over 500 million global streams, chart-topping recording artist **Chad Lawson** performs works for solo piano on **March 28**. The **Verona String Quartet**, winners of the coveted Cleveland Quartet Award (2020), makes their first appearance in Brevard on **April 11** in a program of beloved chamber music. The 2023/24 Parker Concert Hall series comes to a close on **May 14** with the incomparable piano virtuoso **Olga Kern** in recital.
