Leading All-Female Chamber Ensemble Comes to Brevard

Brevard, North Carolina — Brevard Music Center (BMC) continues its Parker Concert Hall Fall Series on **Tuesday, October 26 at 7:30pm** with **"The Eroica Trio."** One of the most sought after trios in the world, this Grammy-nominated ensemble enraptures audiences with flawless technical virtuosity, irresistible enthusiasm, and sensual elegance. The three women who make up this celebrated ensemble electrify the concert stage with their passionate performances. Their Brevard program will include works by Bach, Mendelssohn, and more. The Trio won the prestigious Naumburg Award, resulting in a highly successful Lincoln Center debut and has since toured the United States, Europe, Middle East, South America and Asia. While maintaining their demanding concert schedule, the Eroica Trio has released eight critically lauded recordings for Angel/EMI classics Records, garnering them multiple Grammy nominations. The first all-female chamber ensemble to reach the top echelon of the field, the women of the Eroica Trio have shattered the age-old gender barrier, leading the vanguard and inspiring many to follow.

Parker Concert Hall is Brevard Music Center's state-of-the-art venue overlooking scenic Lake Milner. This season the hall plays host to a twelve-concert series from October through May featuring a varied lineup of classical, jazz, vocal, and fusion artists. The series continues on **Thursday, November 9**, with **"Classic Silent Cinema,"** featuring pipa player, Min Xiao-Fen and percussionist, River Guerguerian.
