BREVARD MUSIC CENTER PRESENTS "ITALIAN NIGHT" AT THE PARKER CONCERT HALL ON DECEMBER 11

Steep Canyon Rangers Mike Guggino & Barrett Smith joined by special guest Carlo Aonzo

Brevard, North Carolina — Brevard Music Center (BMC) continues its popular Parker Concert Hall (PCH) Fall Series on December 11 at 7:30 p.m. with "Italian Night," presented in partnership with Mountain Song Productions. Acclaimed musicians Mike Guggino (mandolin) and Barrett Smith (guitar), both members of the Grammy Award-winning Steep Canyon Rangers, take center stage at PCH alongside Italian mandolin performer, Carlo Aonzo.

Guggino and Smith have been performing traditional Italian folk music on the mandolin and guitar for nearly two decades. When on tour with the Rangers, they often host "Italian Night" performances at local restaurants, music venues, and house concerts. Over the years, these widely popular events have provided them the perfect setting to develop their own unique musical expression of these exotic and familial songs. In 2021, the duo released *Mia Dolce Faralla* on CD and Vinyl, a "remarkable work" (BlueGrassToday.com) that reflects their inspirations and love for Italian folk music.
