GRAMMY-Winning Yellowjackets Take the Stage at Brevard Music Center June 7

Brevard, NC – June 5, 2025 – Brevard Music Center welcomes the legendary jazz fusion ensemble **Yellowjackets** for a one-night-only performance on **Saturday, June 7 at 7:30 p.m.** at Whittington-Pfohl Auditorium. Part of the **BMC Presents** concert series, this high-energy outdoor show is a rare opportunity to hear one of the most influential jazz groups of the past four decades, live in the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains.

With more than 25 albums, 17 GRAMMY nominations, and over 40 years of innovation, the Yellowjackets have defined and redefined the sound of contemporary jazz. Their signature blend of improvisation, groove, and genre-defying style continues to inspire audiences and musicians worldwide.

The performance also coincides with **BMC's Jazz Institute**, a two-week intensive program for young jazz musicians from across the country. While in residence, the Yellowjackets will lead a **masterclass for Jazz Institute students**, offering direct mentorship and insight into life as a professional musician.

"Having our students work directly with a band like the Yellowjackets is absolutely priceless," said **Jason Posnock**, President & CEO of Brevard Music Center. "Their decades of road experience, real-world musicianship, and artistic resilience offer a kind of education no classroom alone can provide. It's an unforgettable opportunity for the next generation of jazz artists."
