Brevard Music Center Launches 2025 Summer Festival with Chopin, ABBA, Mendelssohn, and Bluegrass Legends

BREVARD, NC — June 17, 2025 — Brevard Music Center kicks off its 2025 Summer Festival this week with an unforgettable lineup that spans classical masterpieces, pop nostalgia, intimate chamber music, and high-energy bluegrass—all set against the breathtaking backdrop of the Blue Ridge Mountains.

On Friday, June 20 at 7:30 PM, acclaimed conductor JoAnn Falletta leads the Brevard Music Center Orchestra in a powerful Opening Night performance. Pianist Eric Lu performs Chopin's Piano Concerto No. 2, in a program that also features works by Jennifer Higdon and Saint-Saëns.

On **Saturday, June 21 at 7:30 PM**, the world's premier ABBA tribute band takes the stage for *The Concert: A Tribute to ABBA*, delivering a dazzling night of chart-topping pop classics in full 70s style.

On **Sunday, June 22 at 3:00 PM**, rising star **Nathan Amaral** performs **Mendelssohn's Violin Concerto** with the **Brevard Sinfonia**, in a wide-ranging program that also includes Jennifer Higdon's *Cold Mountain Suite*, Tcherepnin's *La Princesse Lointaine*, and Tchaikovsky's *Francesca da Rimini*.

On **Monday, June 23 at 7:30 PM**, Brevard's Artist Faculty present *Debussy Danses*, a luminous evening of chamber music at **Parker Concert Hall**. The concert features

expressive works by Debussy, Jennifer Higdon, Shostakovich, and Nielsen—offering an intimate listening experience in one of the region's most architecturally stunning venues.

Then on **Tuesday, June 24 at 7:30 PM**, Brevard welcomes back **Steep Canyon Rangers**— this time joined by the Brevard Festival Orchestra under the baton of Ken Lam. Copresented with Mountain Song Productions, this genre-blending concert promises virtuosic playing, tight harmonies, and a joyful fusion of bluegrass and symphonic sound.

All performances take place at Brevard Music Center's scenic campus venues, including **Whittington-Pfohl Auditorium** and **Parker Concert Hall**. Tickets and full season information are available at www.brevardmusic.org.
